Senate elections for the University of Vienna will take place on Thursday May 16, 2019 and YOU are entitled to vote!

The University of Vienna's Senate is comprised of nine full professors, four members of the academic staff, four students, and one member of the non-academic staff - <http://senat.univie.ac.at/>

The Kritische Liste GakuPlumIG alliance asks for your vote. Our alliance supports the egalitarian and analytical consideration of the interests of ALL academic staff members (including student assistants, tutors, lecturers, senior lecturers, pre- and post-docs, research project academic staff, assistant and associate professors, and all civil servants). We support a democratic university organization and personnel structure that functions independently of university hierarchies (*Kurien-System*) and considers the individual interests of all university employees.

The Kritische Liste GakuPlumIG represents and defends the interests of all members of the University of Vienna's academic staff. Our most important objectives for the Senate are:

- Active democracy at the university and the reduction of hierarchical structures (faculty instead of Kurien System)
- Representation of all academic staff in developmental planning
- Increased opportunity for permanent employment and the substantial increase of positions at all academic staff levels
- More permanent lecturer positions and full-time senior lecturer contracts
- A significant increase in career perspectives for junior researchers at the university
- More transparency & participation of all academic staff in tenure track hiring proceedings
- More transparency in Associate Professor tenure proceedings (Qualifizierungsvereinbarungen)
- A lower teacher to student ratio
- Equal distribution of courses and lectures with high student enrolment
- Equal distribution of final paper and degree thesis supervision responsibilities
- Increased participation of all academic staff in developing curricula
- Appropriate and scientifically meaningful evaluation of all courses and lectures
- Equal, transparent, and balanced distribution of resources (money and staff) independent of current university hierarchies
- An effective policy of equality at all levels of employment at the University of Vienna
